Child Care Subsidy Program
242-1608**

Up to \$200.00 monthly subsidy for care at a DHS licensed family child care provider, preschool, or infant/toddler center.

- ✓ Maui County families of children birth through 4 who do not qualify for any assistance from other child care subsidy programs, or do not qualify for enough assistance to make tuition reasonably affordable.
- ✓ Income requirement (see table below)
- ✓ Parents/guardians working, in school, or job training for at least 30 hours per week
- ✓ Retired grandparents raising their grandchildren may be eligible
- ✓ Emergency/Special situations considered on case by case basis

Application period is April 15 to June 30, 2017 to be considered in first pool of applicants for aid starting September 2017. Applications submitted after June 15 will be accepted, but may have to be waitlisted pending availability of funds.

PATCH Preschool Open Doors

Application Period

May 1, 2017 – May 31, 2017

For aid available July 2017 through June 2018

Preschool Open Doors (POD) is a statewide early childhood education and care project funded by the State of Hawaii Department of Human Services. POD helps children go to preschool by helping families pay preschool cost for up to one year. Any licensed preschool may accept POD children.

Children who may be eligible for aid for preschool July 2017 – June 2018 are:

- Children born from August 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012
- Children born from January 1, 2013 to July 31, 2013

There is no work requirement for parents, but families must meet the gross income eligibility limits in the table below. POD has sliding fee scales, based upon State of Hawaii child care assistance guidelines. Depending on family size and income, families may be required to pay some of the monthly preschool costs. **Funds are limited.**

Pauahi Keiki Scholars (PKS) is a scholarship for eligible keiki attending KS-eligible preschools in Hawai'i.

- ✓ Hawaiian ancestry
- ✓ Be a state of Hawaii resident
- ✓ Enrolled in a PKS eligible preschool
- ✓ 3 & 4 year old keiki
- ✓ Demonstrate financial need
