  - >Licensed Family Child Care
  - >Licensed Center Based Care
  - >Before/After school Care
  - >Intercession/Summer Care
  - >Licensed Exempt Child Care
  - >Child Care for Special Needs Children
- Work with providers to help strengthen their programs

# Tips for Choosing Quality Care

#### ARE YOU LOOKING FOR CHILD CARE?

Here are some tips on choosing child care:

### > What type of care are you looking for:

Licensed Home Care? Licensed Center Care? Licensed-Exempt Home Care? Before/After school Care? Intercession/Summer Care?

## > Identify the providers you want to contact:

Need help? See the Additional Child Care resources section on help to find a provider.

# > Interview providers:

Even if they are related to you, it's good to ask questions

### > Visit their home or center, do they:

Do activities with the children?
Have age appropriate toys?
Talk to and read to the children?
Praise the children?
Know how to encourage appropriate behavior?
Provide a safe environment?

#### > Check at least two references:

Contact parents who have or are. currently using their services.

#### > Make a decision:

Trust your instincts! Ask more questions if needed.

# > Follow up

Is your child happy?
Ask questions if you have concerns.
It's OK to make a change if you feel it's needed.
