Subsidy applications for the 2020-21 preschool year are accepted now through May 2021, but may be waitlisted pending availability of funding.

Subsidy applications for the 2021-22 preschool year will be available March 1, 2020 but call 242-1608 now to be placed on the Application Mailing List.

- Up to \$200.00 monthly subsidy for care at a DHS licensed family child care provider, preschool, or infant/toddler center
- Maui County families of children ages birth until eligible for Kindergarten who do not qualify for any assistance from other child care subsidy programs, or do not qualify for enough assistance to make tuition affordable.
- Income requirement (see table)
- Parents/guardians working, in school, or job training for at least 30 hours per week
- Retired grandparents raising their grandchildren may be eligible
- Emergency/Special situations considered on case by case basis
